25 Years and Counting

September marks the 25th anniversary of the dedication of the Watson W. Wise Medical Research Library. Mr. Wise responded to the needs of the Health Center's burgeoning research programs by donating 10-year backfiles of over 80 journals, and these journals virtually doubled the Library's space requirements. The Library moved from scattered offices that are now occupied by Family Medicine, the old Library, and the passageway from D Building to the Riter Center. The new Library occupied (and still occupies) areas previously housing Respiratory Therapy and the Microbiology/Immunology research labs.

Logging in from Off Campus

When accessing Library e-journals and databases from off campus, be sure to click the red link (**Click here to log in with your UTHCT network username and password.**) to log in. The login boxes below the red link are for an old password system that is used mainly for testing. Your current login will not work there.

Elsevier Backfiles

UT System has been purchasing backfiles of selected Elsevier electronic journals. These are being added to the Library's WebVoyage catalog and the e-journal database. However, Elsevier has not provided PubMed with links to all of the Elsevier backfiles that are available to us. Be aware that we will sometimes have electronic access to older volumes of a journal that do not have full text icons in PubMed. Use

WebVoyage or the e-journal database

(<http://library.uthct.edu/fulltext.htm>) to access articles from the selected Elsevier backfiles that are not linked from PubMed.

For example, we have web access to the Journal of Molecular Biology back to 1959. Elsevier has only provided links in PubMed back to 1966. To get older articles from that journal, you would need to go to the Library's online catalog or to the Library's e-journal database.

Other Elsevier backfiles will be available soon.

JANE (Journal/Author Name Estimator) is a free web site that helps determine the best journals to publish specific articles in based on

the subject or title of your proposed article. JANE is located at <http://biosemantics.org/jane/>. See <http://eigenfactor.org/> for information on the citation measurements used by JANE.
